

Frequently Asked Questions about TLC 2009-10

Am I registered for the McAuliffe Conference?

Yes. NCES sent registration and payment for a one-day general registration for the day you indicated on the TLC Application Form you completed.

When will we receive our iPod Touch?

You can pick up your iTouch at NCES on any of the following dates:

- November 30 at the optional iTouch intro session
- January 15 at the Intel Session #1 (mandatory for teams, optional for admin)
- January 28 at the optional iTouch intro session
- Any other time as arranged with NCES (call/email ahead to make sure someone is available to sign over the iTouch to you)

Can someone else pick up my iTouch for me?

Yes, but they will have to sign for it.

What about the MITI session on using the iTouch at McAuliffe?

This session is NOT affiliated with your participation in TLC or with receiving an iPod Touch through this project. If you wanted to attend this session at McAuliffe, you would have had to register for it separately and pay the additional fee. The session did fill quickly, so if you have not already registered, it's too late.

Is there an iTouch session at Christa McAuliffe related to the TLC project?

Yes, but is not listed in the program booklet and it is only for the administrators who are in the project. Bill Carozza and Christine Martin will provide a one hour session from 10:30 to 11:30 on Tuesday, Dec 1 to highlight a few ways they use the iTouch as administrators. This is an optional session and it is first come, first serve. It will take place in the Northwood Room. The session may be repeated from 1:00 to 2:00 if there is enough interest. You can check with the LESCN representatives in the Northwood Room on Dec 1 to see if the session will be repeated at 1:00 (a final decision hasn't been yet).

When do we meet?

Please see the attached Master Schedule. Be sure to look at "who" each date is for since it includes dates for all TLC activities for both team members and the participating administrators.

What about the online component?

Susan Kessler will be the facilitator/moderator. Team members will be expected to spend 3-6 hours per month from December through August in the online "course". The administrator involvement has not been fully determined/defined at this time. Around mid-December, expect to see an email from Susan or Cathy Higgins about login information and more details.

Other things you should know:

There are 11 teams representing the North Country region. You are part of a group of 35 people from the region. There are three other consortiums participating in TLC. Those are being coordinated through CACES in Penacook, SWnhESC in Keene and SPDC in Exeter.
